**JOB PURPOSE:**

Responsible for performing assigned biological and chemical analyses of drinking water, waste water, and stream samples submitted to the Water Quality Laboratory; to calculate and report results of those analyses in support of the various operations of the Environmental Services Division (ESD)

Technical Manager

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The duties and responsibilities of the **Laboratory Technician** include but are not limited to the following:

- Perform water quality analyses under the direct supervision of the Technical Manager or the ESD Managers
- Keep accurate, legible records of data generated
- Prepare reagents and standards according to standard operating procedures
- Prepare glassware and any other apparatus necessary to perform analyses
- Calculate and post analytical results and enter data into the ESD LIMS System in accordance with standard operating procedure
- Interpret analytical results and report any questionable data to the Technical Manager, ESD Managers, or the QA Officer
- Operate and maintain applicable laboratory equipment
- Participate in quality assurance and safety programs as required
- Assist in receiving samples submitted to the laboratory for analyses
- Perform any other duties assigned by the Technical Manager, ESD Managers

## **EDUCATIONAL AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:**

- A diploma from an accredited high school with minimum high school or college course work that includes one year of algebra and one year of biology or chemistry
- Must be able to make unbiased observations and interpretations and to keep an accurate record of all data and analysis results
- Must be capable and willing to perform assigned tasks with minimal supervision and work unusual or flexible hours as needed
- Problem-solving and analytical-thinking skills are desirable
- Must have a valid Driver's License and a good driving record
