Lake Accessibility – September 29, 2011

During times of lower lake levels, safe access to the reservoirs is limited and extreme caution should be used when accessing the reservoir. A list of generally accessible boat ramps is provided below to assist boaters and recreational users in accessing the reservoir. Boat ramps will be inspected and this report will be updated periodically. These conditions are based on current lake levels and can change daily. Public and commercial boat ramps with fair accessibility to the reservoir along with the current lake level are listed below:

Toledo Bend Lake Level (9/29/2011): 160.55 feet msl

Record Lake Low of 160.53 feet msl was recorded on 9/27/2011
